## Quarantine Blanket Project

Dear fellow knitters and crocheters,

Join CloseKnit staff in making a quarantine blanket.  
Let's make a dent into our stashes, knit (or crochet)  
panels and assemble them to a blanket to donate to charity.

Worsted weight washable yarn is best. Something like Encore,  
super-wash wool or the like.

Cast on 40 stitches.

On size 6 (if you knit loose like Christine)

on size 7 (if you are usually on gauge like Barbara and Lucie)

on size 8 (if you knit tight like Glenda)

and knit a square or panel of any length.

Piece should be about 9 inches wide.

Suggestions for making it fun

Use different color each day

Finish each day with 2 rows of contrasting color.

Use different pattern each day.

Just knit for relaxation.

Knit or crochet now, drop off panels at the store after April 7.

I will try to complete the blanket by the end of May.

Each participant will get a ticket to a raffle for goodies from CloseKnit.

Let's show our collective creativity and strength.
